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## Release Notes for Invoice Express 1.4.0


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Marketron announces the integration of **Invoice Express** with the **Marketron Exchange** platform for streamlined electronic invoicing to agencies.

Invoice Express 1.4 routes invoice data directly to agencies based on their current delivery preferences. This streamlined process means agencies will no longer be required to use the AgencyMinder/eMediaTRADE web portal to retrieve their invoices.

This update to Invoice Express adds the power of the Marketron Exchange to your invoice transmissions. Marketron Exchange is growing quickly as the central hub for electronic data transmissions—receiving orders from agencies, rep firms and your own proposal software, and sending proof-of-performance data and invoices to buyers.

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Once this update is installed, there is no configuration or setup required. You do not need to change ID codes or settings on your existing agency and order entries.

This release involves installing **two** product updates from us:

1. *Microsoft Components* installation to version **1.6.0**
2. *Invoice Express* software to version **1.4.0**


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- After the update, invoices designated to be delivered via **AgencyMinder** will first be routed to Marketron Exchange. Almost instantly, the Exchange will then decide if the invoice can be delivered directly to the agency, or if it still needs to go to the AgencyMinder.com website portal.

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 **NOTE** - Invoices delivered directly to the recipient will no longer be processed or viewable in the AgencyMinder.com website portal.

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- Over time, more and more agency invoices will be able to be routed directly, rather than the agency needing to retrieve them from the AgencyMinder.com website. The result is more-timely delivery of invoice data, quicker analysis by the agency, quicker identification and resolution of any discrepancies, and it can mean quicker payment to your station.
- The Invoice Express **Admin Console** takes on a more important role in checking the delivery status of invoices. Be sure to check the Admin Console regularly, after each invoice run, for any invoice transmission attempts that result in errors (noted by a red icon.) Use the “Display Messages” option to display information about where the transmittal process failed. With this information, Marketron Support can help you troubleshoot.

Following is a listing of some of the possible messages you may see in the Admin Console:

Message	Explanation
<b>Processed Successfully</b>	The invoice was successfully delivered to Marketron Exchange, and the Exchange was able to route it either directly to the agency, or to the AgencyMinder.com website portal.
<b>EI: &lt;&lt;a message describing a problem&gt;&gt;</b>	The invoice was processed by the Marketron Exchange, and the Exchange identified the agency as one which could be directly delivered. But there was a problem of some sort with the delivery.
<b>AgyMdr: &lt;&lt;a message describing a problem&gt;&gt;</b>	The invoice was processed by the Marketron Exchange, and the Exchange identified the agency as one which still needed to be delivered via the "AgencyMinder.com" website portal. But there was a problem of some sort with the delivery.
<b>Exchange: Invalid Marketron Code</b>	The invoice was received at the Marketron Exchange, but the agency cannot be found in our database. Thus, the Exchange does not know how or where to deliver the invoice. In most cases, this is caused by a missing agency code number on the invoice. Check to be sure the proper "EMT" or "EI" code exists on the agency record or invoice.
<b>Exchange: Marketron Client Disabled</b>	The invoice was received at the Marketron Exchange, and a valid "EMT" or "EI" code is present. But the agency/advertiser is marked as "Inactive" in Marketron's database. Although this is very rare, reasons include the agency is in the middle of a transition of their software system, or other business factors, such as being acquired by another agency.
